

Using the original drawings by Joseph Finger, Architect, as a basis for restoration work, this 1934 retail building was restored and converted into a mixed use development that will eventually include retail and residential. The completed second and third floors include five loft-style condominiums, a restaurant and smaller retail shops are planned for the basement, first floor, and mezzanine. The facade, constructed of smooth cut Cordova Cream limestone with a Verdi Green Marble base along the exterior wall is considered a fine example the of the Moderne Style.
